LEED-CI™: ACHIEVING THE ENERGY AND IEQ POINTS

Puget Sound Energy Headquarters and Park 90/5 Building A, City of Seattle are two buildings recently awarded certification under the newly released LEED-CI Guideline for Commercial Interiors. LEED-CI serves building owners and occupants as well as the interior designers and architects who design building interiors and the teams of professionals who install them. LEED-CI addresses performance areas including: selection of tenant space; efficiency of water usage; energy performance optimization including lighting and lighting controls; HVAC Systems, and Equipment; resource utilization for interior building systems and furnishings, and; indoor environmental quality including criteria for emissions, thermal comfort, daylight and views.
